

Client's Bill of Rights

The state of Minnesota has not adopted any educational & training standards for unlicensed complementary & alternative health care practitioners. This statement of credentials is for information purposes only.

Under Minnesota law, an unlicensed complementary & alternative health care practitioner may not provide a medical diagnosis or recommend discontinuance of medically prescribed treatments. If a client desires services from any other type of health care provider, the client may seek such services at any time.

1. Degrees, training, and experience of practitioner. Sue C. Mills has graduated from 4 years of training at the Northwestern Academy of Homeopathy in Minneapolis. This included some conventional courses in anatomy, physiology, chemistry, biology, microbiology, ect. She has also worked at Westside Natural Health services as a colon therapist for 25 years.

2. Right to file a complaint. If you have any concerns, you may file a complaint with the following state office.

3. Fees for unit of service. The first session is 2 hours at \$220.00 for 2 hours of the initial case taking and an unknown amount of hours in choosing a remedy. Follow ups that last 1 hour will be \$60.

4. Change in services or charges. You will be notified prior to any changes in services or charges.

5. Description of services. Please see the article "Homeopathy: What you need to know," available at any time.

6. Information about assessment & recommended service. You have a right to complete & current information concerning any assessment & recommended service, including the possible duration of the service to be provided.

7. Courteous treatment . You can expect courteous treatment and to be free from verbal, physical, or sexual abuse

8. Confidentiality of client information. Your records and other information about you are confidential. This information will not be released, unless you authorize release in writing or unless release is required by law.

9. Access to client records. You are allowed to access records & other written information in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 144.335.

10. Other available services. If you are interested in other available services in the community, you may wish to consult the Minnesota Homeopathic Association.

11. Change practitioners. You have the right to choose any of the available practitioners available or to change to a different clinic after services have begun. If you change practitioners, you will have our assistance in this transfer.

13. Refusing services. You have the right to refuse the services or treatment, unless otherwise provided by law.

14. No retaliation. You may assert your rights without retaliation.
